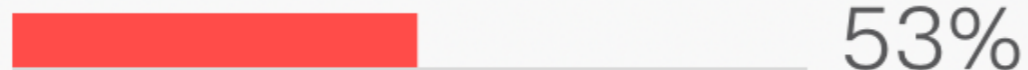


More 'uncivil' tweets mention Trump than Clinton

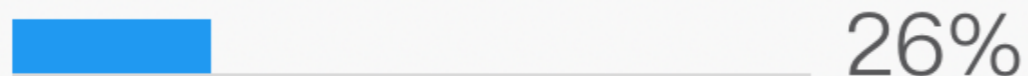
6% of election-related tweets during the month of July were "uncivil," according to an analysis by Electome. Tweets are classified as uncivil if they contain profanity, insults, ethnic or sexual slurs, or violent terms.

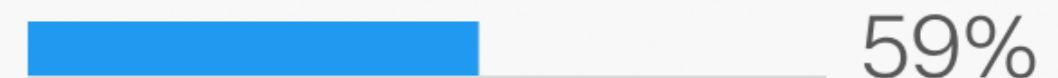


More than half of 'uncivil' tweets by Clinton followers mention Trump

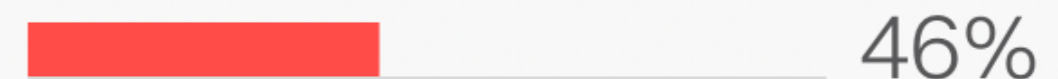
